

Programme description	This Samoan course responds to the expectations of the NZ curriculum Level 1 Samoan. Students must have a background knowledge of Samoan, either by learning Year 9 and 10 or family/ surrounding speaking the language. The course will include listening, reading, speaking, writing and conversation skills
Topics	Topics <u>include</u> : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The understanding of a variety of Samoan texts on areas of most immediate relevance 2. Spoken text on areas of most relevance 3. Writing a variety of text types in Samoan on areas of most immediate relevance 4. A spoken presentation in Samoan that communicates a personal response
Prerequisites	Students must have a basic understanding of Samoan Language
Required	Background knowledge of Samoan sufficient to study at this level, and the commitment to complete the course
Assessment	The course consists of two internal assessments and two external assessments. A total of 19 credits will be offered.
