

<b>Programme description</b>	This programme Samoan language level 2 provides an insight into Samoan thought, culture and Samoan society. The main focus of this course is to develop competence in listening, speaking, reading and writing in Samoan and to develop an understanding of the Samoan language and Fa'aSamoa (Samoan Way/Culture).
<b>Topics</b>	Topics <u>include</u> : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Relationships</li> <li>2. Historical events</li> <li>3. Recreation</li> <li>4. Environment</li> <li>5. Fa'asāmoa</li> </ol>
<b>Prerequisites</b>	NCEA Level 1 Students must have completed Years 10 and Level 1 Samoan or must have prior knowledge of the language sufficient to enable them to enter at this level (Entry to the course will be at the discretion of the TiC)
