

Programme description	Level 2 Biology has a large number of credits (17 internal, 12 external). Students should aim to complete around 18 of these credits with at least one external. With the large scope available in these standards the course content will be tailored to suit the students needs.
Content	The Level 2 Biology course covers a wide range of topics. Microbiology, genetics, evolution and ecology can all be studied.
Prerequisites	Year 11 Science is helpful.
Required	Students will need a workbook and they will need to be able to access Google Classroom.
Assessment	Students will focus on completing the internals by the end of Term 2. Term 3 and 4 will focus on the external standards.
